## The Hunt

MNO guides provide a variety of hunting options or can accommodate a personal choice. Tree stands or box blinds are the most common options with ground hunting for those wishing to take the ultimate challenge. Ladder stands, tripods, and portable tree stands are all used by MNO guides so let us know if you have a preference. We also cater to the hunter with limited physical capacity by customizing a hunting stand or location to suit their needs. Whitetail deer hunts start with arrival on Sunday, hunting Sunday to Saturday at noon with departure on Saturday afternoon. Archery, muzzleloader, and rifle licenses are available with seasons ranging from August to the end of November. If you bag your deer, options for other hunts or sporting events will be made available. Fishing, ice fishing, bird, duck and geese hunting are included (licenses available upon request) in the original price depending on

climate, season and access. (i.e. freeze up may restrict access to lakes or migratory birds may have headed South).

Any open Manitoba big game license can bag a timber wolf and continue hunting the specific big game. Three-day bird hunts start on Monday through to noon on Wednesday and from Thursday to noon on Saturday. Three morning and two afternoon hunts for duck, geese, or upland game bird are selected by the client and run from September to the end of October.

## Game

All game taken by MNO clients will be processed, packaged and frozen for the hunter.

Shipping containers for mounts are provided and insulated coolers can be purchased from MNO.

Professional taxidermists are made available upon request.

## Climate / Clothing

Clients are advised to contact David for advice on clothing and footwear. While September is consistent in temperature, October and November can provide a wide range of climate changes requiring warm clothing. A mail-order service for suitable clothing is available through SIR Warehouse Sports Store of Winnipeg, [www.sirmailorder.ca](http://www.sirmailorder.ca), and a catalogue will be provided upon request.

Ammunition and fish and bird licenses are available at SIR which is a five minute drive from the Winnipeg Airport. MNO will take all clients to SIR upon pickup if during working hours of the store; otherwise arrangements will be made in advance.

MNO provides cold weather clothing in sizes Large to XXL. Hunters coming to Manitoba from areas not having colder weather need not incur extra expense for outer garments. Arrangements for clothing at no extra cost can be made at the time of booking.

## Licensing

Big Game licenses will be provided at a cost of \$300.<sup>00</sup> US.

Migratory Bird licenses can be obtained from Magnum North Outfitters.
